

SPRING KIT LIST

For your reference, please keep this list for future camps

All of the following items are necessary and must accompany your child to camp. Please do not send any new or irreplaceable items. Camp is a great place for old and comfortable clothes! Campers are required to carry their own luggage, so please limit baggage to one piece of luggage, a bedroll, and a small daypack.

PLEASE MARK ALL ARTICLES CLEARLY WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME

CLOTHING (dress for the weather)

- Uniform (worn to & from camp, sash not required)
- 2 (or more) pairs of socks
- 2 (or more) pair of underwear
- 1 pair of long pants (wool or poly keep heat in better)
- 1 long sleeve shirt
- 2 pairs of shorts
- 1 T-shirts
- 1 heavy sweater/sweatshirt/polar fleece (hoody)
- 1 warm jacket (water resistant)
- 1 pair of hiking boots
- 1 other pairs of sturdy footwear (running shoes)
- Toque, mitts or gloves- bring extra (not for sleeping)
- Rain gear (raincoat/poncho with hood or rain hat) & waterproof boots

SLEEPING GEAR (BEDROLL)

- Ground sheet (6' x 8' is a good size)
- Warm sleeping bag
- Pillow case or small camp pillow
- Sleeping bag liner or extra blanket (campfire blanket)
- Sleeping pad (air mattresses are not a good idea)
- Warm pyjamas or sweat suit for sleeping
- Toque to sleep in (not for hiking or other activities)
- All wrapped & tied in a sturdy plastic tarp (ground sheet) or waterproof stuff sack (dry sack). **Do not send bedrolls wrapped in garbage bags.**

MESS KIT (Unbreakable and a in mesh bag)

- Plate/Bowl
- Cup/Mug with handle (not metal)
- Knife/Fork/Spoon (metal)

TOILET KIT

- Toothbrush, toothpaste and dental floss
- Hand soap (in container)
- Hand towel and washcloth
- Brush/comb

OTHER

- Wide-brim hat
- Sun protection and insect repellent (non-aerosol)
- Small knapsack suitable for day use
- Water bottle (that can be carried)
- 5 clothespins
- Flashlight/headlamp with extra batteries
- Medication (see note below)

- 10 12 foot length of sturdy reusable rope - to tie bedroll
- Laundry Bag (to keep dirty clothes)
- Cub Book plus note book and a pencil or pen

OPTIONAL

- Book to read, cards, etc.
- Sit-upon
- Campfire blanket
- Sleeping buddy
- Camera (inexpensive) & film
- Sunglasses
- Emergency/survival kit
- Compass & Binoculars
- Walking stick

MEDICATION - ensure that all medication is handed to a LEADER. All medication should be in original container, or clearly marked (a photocopy of the prescription bottle label) with the drug. Please enclose written instructions.

NOT ALLOWED

Electronic devices (Toys, video games, radios, etc.), food

Absolutely no food, chips, candy or gum! We have plenty of food and it will only attract animals and leads to extra work for the leaders to clean up after camp.
