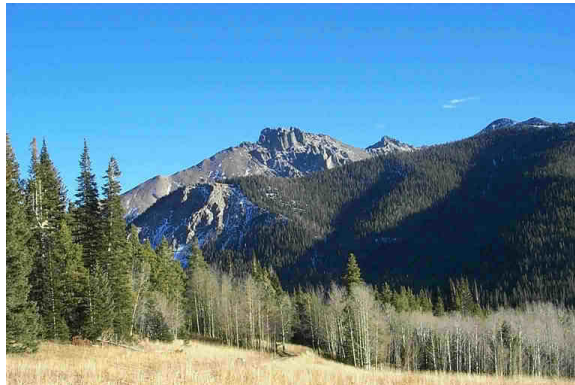

Example Trees & Plants

- Rocky Mt. Evergreen
 - Ponderosa pine
 - Douglas-fir
 - Engelmann spruce.



- Pacific Coast Evergreen
 - Western Hemlock, Douglas-fir, Sitka Spruce (in temperate rain forests near coast), Western Redcedar, Coast Redwoods (limited to CA fog belt where otherwise dry summer), White Fir and Giant Sequoias in the Sierra Nevada mountane zone



- Northern Mixed
 - Beech, Maple, Eastern Hemlock, Yellow Birch, White Pine, Northern Whitecedar



Example Trees & Plants

- Eastern Deciduous
 - Beech - maple - yellow poplar,
oak - hickory,
mixed pine,
hardwood



- Coastal Plain Evergreen
 - Southern Pines, Oaks,
Evergreen Magnolia, Bald-cypress,
Spanish Moss,
some Palms



- Prairie
 - Big Bluestem Grass,
various grasses and forbs,
red cedar and Osage orange
in eastern transition



Example Trees & Plants

- Cool Desert
 - Sagebrush,
Pinyon-Juniper Woodlands



- Hot Desert
 - Creosote Bush,
Large Cacti,
Yuccas,
Paloverde



- Mediterranean Scrub
 - Flammable shrubs,
Manzanitas,
Ceanothus,
Mandrone
