

# Cub Scout Uniforms

- **Shirt:**
  - Official Cub Scout long- or short-sleeve Navy Blue shirt.
  - Webelos have option of wearing Official Boy Scout long- or short-sleeve Tan shirt.
- **Belt:**
  - Official Navy Blue web belt with metal buckle; buckle emblem varies by Rank (see next page).
- **Neckerchiefs:**
  - Official triangular Neckerchief; color varies by Rank (see next page).
- **Neckerchief Slides:**
  - Official gold-colored metal slide with Rank emblem (see next page).
  - Handmade neckerchief slides may also be worn.
- **Pants**
  - Official Cub Scout Navy Blue pants, shorts, or “switch backs”.
  - Webelos who wear the Tan uniform shirt wear the Green pants, shorts, or “switch backs”.
- **Cap:**
  - Official Cub Scout baseball-style cap; color varies by Rank (see next page)
- **Socks:**
  - Official Navy Blue Cub Scout socks with Gold tops.
  - Webelos who wear the Tan uniform shirt wear the Green Boy Scout socks with Red tops.

# How to Wear the Neckerchief

- Fold the long edge over several small flat folds to about 6 inches from the tip of the neckerchief. A tight fold prevents gathering around the neck and is more efficient than rolling or twirling.
  - Iron the folds flat for a better fit under the collar.
- Place around the neck over turned-under collar of uniform shirt. Or, wear under shirt collar if desired.
- Draw neckerchief slide over ends and adjust to fit snugly. Let neckerchief ends hang loose.
- The portion of the neckerchief showing below the back of the neck should measure no more than 6 inches.



# Adult Uniform Options

- Adult Leaders wear the Tan Shirt w/Green Pants
  - Short or long sleeve shirt
  - Shorts, long pants, or “switch-backs”
  - Female Leaders have the option of wearing the Yellow Shirt w/ Blue Skirt
- Three different Leader Neckerchiefs are available (Tiger Leader, Cub Scout Leader, Webelos Leader)
  - Optional Bolo Tie with Cub Scout emblem can also be worn
  - Open collar with no Neckerchief is also allowed with the short sleeve shirts  
(However, it’s harder to get the boys to wear their Neckerchief if the Leader doesn’t wear theirs)
- Leaders can wear the Official Boy Scout Uniform Cap, or the Cap of the Rank they’re Leader for
- We highly encourage Leaders to wear the Complete Uniform
  - The best way to get the boys to wear the Uniform correctly is for the Leaders to wear their Uniform correctly
  - Set a goal for yourself – by the end of your first year as leader, have the complete Uniform
