Treasurer **John Sykes**

Keeps track of the pack bank account. Collects dues. Reimburses for pack purchases.

☞ **Advancement Coordinator** **Marybeth Fowler**

Primarily during the school year. In charge of Cub Scout Advancements – like rank badges, beltloops, academic pins, activity pins. A detail-oriented position, den leaders submit advancements earned before the pack meeting. The Advancement Coordinator goes to the Council shop to purchase awards on the Pack account.
