

# WELCOME TO PACK 38

Hello and welcome to Pack 38. Please read through this brief packet and, hopefully, we will answer any questions you may have.

Our Pack is sponsored by Brazos Bend Elementary School and meets as a pack once a month at Walker Station Elementary School, usually the first Monday of every month from 7:00 pm to 8:15 pm. Individual Dens, smaller groups of boys, meet separately, usually twice a month.

The "Pack" is our large unit, comprising of 60-80 boys. The Pack is split into smaller groups of 6-8 boy units called Dens, based on their age/grade level and if possible neighborhood locale. Cub Scouts is a family oriented program that gives the boys the opportunity for many experiences while learning to become good citizens. The boys learn by doing while having FUN.

Volunteer leadership runs the Pack and Dens. If not called upon to be a Leader, you will certainly be requested to fill a Pack Committee or Activity position. We are an active group that runs on the steam of our adult volunteers who, just like you, have other commitments (job, family, sports, church, etc.) that compete for their time. However, just as for the boys, the time you devote to Cub Scouting will be fun and rewarding.
